TOPAZ DUAL SPORT SELF GUIDING ROLL CHARTS

Start/Finish @ Topaz Lodge both Days

Located on Hwy 395 at Ca/Nv state line

Using as much Single Track and Jeep Roads as possible

For quiet, street-legal Dual Sport Motorcycles

Because of restrictive BLM regulations, an organized Dual Sport ride is not practical. However, you can purchase our self guiding Dual Sport Roll Charts through the mail and organize your own Dual Sport ride. You may obviously use these charts any time you want. For safety reasons, you should never ride alone.

- Ordered, Sold, and Delivered ONLY through the mail
- Absolutely not available at any scheduled Adventure Bike Tour
- Available in Early August

Pick two of these three all day loops that you want to ride;

Mt. Patterson loop, 120 Mi, 90 Mi on gas, optional 25 Mi Bodie loop. It goes over 11,700 ft. Mt. Patterson, through ghost towns of Belfort and Masonic. Lunch & gas in Bridgeport. This loop has many miles single track and rough 2-track jeep roads.

Ebbetts-Carson loop, 200 Mi, 96 Mi on gas. It goes up Hwy 4 over 9,000 ft Ebbetts pass to Bear Reservoir for lunch & gas, then over 8,500 ft Carson Pass (Hwy 88), then over 9,000 ft Forestdale Divide, and back over Ebbetts pass to Topaz. This loop has the most single track with many miles of very difficult trail.

Ebbetts-Sonora loop, 210 Mi, 95 Mi on gas. It goes up over 9,000 ft Ebbetts pass (Hwy 4) to Connell for lunch & gas then down to Hwy 108 and over Sonora Pass, then past the Marine base and back to Topaz. This loop is all easy road.
