- No rider Limit, Walk-Up entries welcome
- Topaz Lodge Motel or Full Hookup RV Park
- Shower room available on Sunday, don't ask for late check out
- Thursday & Friday night sign-in 8-11 PM @ Topaz Lodge
- Friday & Saturday morning sign-in 7-8 AM also @ Topaz Lodge
- You must enter for 3-days to sign-in Thurs night-Friday morning

We have these Five all day loops, you choose the 2 or 3 you want to ride;

Carson Loop (205 Mi, 60 Mi on gas) goes up Hwy 4 over 9,000 ft Ebbetts pass to Bear Reservoir for lunch & gas, then over 8,500 ft Carson Pass (Hwy 88), then over 9,000 ft Forestdale Divide, and back over Ebbetts pass to Topaz. This loop has many miles of fun single track and difficult rocky Jeep Roads. A dawn to dusk very tough ride, not suitable for Adventure Bikes.

Markleeville Loop (65 Mi) Lots of slow single track on way to Markleeville (35 Mi) for early lunch/gas then fast (30 Mi) way back to Topaz for early departure home. This is a very tough ride, not suitable for Adventure Bikes.

Sonora Loop (216 Mi, 90 Mi on gas) goes up over 9,000 ft Ebbetts pass (Hwy 4) to Connell for lunch & gas then down to Hwy 108 and back over Sonora Pass, then past the Marine base to Burcham Flat road back to Topaz. This loop is suitable for Adventure Bikes going all Easy Ways but has several miles of single Track on Hard Ways.

Mt. Patterson Loop* (165 Mi, 110 on gas, optional 25 Mile loop to Aurora) goes over Desert Creek, through ghost town of Masonic to Bodie, then Lunch & Gas in Bridgeport. All county roads, suitable for Adventure Bikes.

Smith Valley Loop (145 Mi, 114 Mi on gas) goes toward Mt Pat but then down Desert Creek and through Smith Valley around the Pine Nuts through Carson Valley to lunch & gas in Markleeville then back to Topaz. Low elevation, all county roads, suitable for Adventure Bikes.

* Because of BLM regulations, an organized Dual Sport ride to Bodie is not practical as part of this event. However you can purchase our Dual Sport Roll Chart through the mail. See Page 3 for details.

Mt. Patterson Loop (195 Mi, 125 Mi on gas) goes over 11,700 ft. Mt. Patterson, through ghost towns of Pine Grove, Aurora, Bodie, Masonic, & Belfort. Lunch & gas in Bridgeport. This loop has many miles single track and rough 2-track jeep roads.
