Start/Finish @ the Dow Villa

North Loop: This loop goes north to gas/lunch in Big Pine. It goes up the east side of the Owens valley and thru the Inyo mountains with lots of Single Tracks. It comes back down the west side of the valley. You can see where hundreds of Cowboy movies were filmed along with other classics like Spencer Tracy's "Bad Day at Black Rock" and Gunga Din.

South Loop: The south loop goes thru Cerro Gordo, then thru Darwin to Panamint Springs for gas/lunch. After lunch, back thru Darwin, around Owens lake past Dirty Sox hot springs across Owens Lake to Boulder RV Park. Then up thru the Alabama Hills and down to Lone Pine. There also is an optional 45 Mi short cut bypassing Panamint Springs for an earlier start home.
